

- in execution thro' the Merits of my dear redeemer Jesus Christ do
- Item I give and bequeath unto my Brother John Hart after my decease my plantation and tract of Land lying on the E side of Mottoway River it being all my lands properly to have and to hold to him and his heirs for ever
- Item It is my will and desire for my three Negroes Namely London Bridget and Caesar to be equally divided after my decease and given unto John Willb Land the son of Nathaniel Land and Elizabeth Daughtrey Carr the daughter of Lawrence Carr to them but in case either John Willb Land or Elizabeth Carr should either or both of them die without lawful heir then the above mentioned Negroes I give unto my Brother John Hart to him and his heirs for ever
- Item I give all the rest of my Estate either real or personal to my Brother John Hart to him and his heirs for ever
- Item I do appoint my Brother John Hart and Nathaniel Land my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and testament as witness my hand and Seal this 4th day of October 1790
