In the name of God amen I Martha Bradshaw
in the parish of Nettonay and County of Southampton being in good health
at present perfect sound mind and memory thanks be given to Almighty God
Do and ordain this my last will and testament in a manner and form followeth First and
principally I give and bequeath my Soul into the hands of the almighty God who
gave it and my body to the Earth to be Buried in due and Christian like manner
at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named and as for what worldly
estate it hath pleased the almighty God to bless me with I give and
Devise and Dispose here of as followeth -

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Philippa Griffen one Feather Bed and
furniture one heffer and Christ one wooling wheel and three Peter
Dishes three Peter Basons one Iron pot and hook the largest one
Iron pot Back four Peter plates one Stone Jug one stone slug one
pore of fire tongs one Christ one large table one spice mortar one
pepper box the same to her and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Prody Bradshaw one feather Bed
and furniture one chest one wooling wheel two Iron pots and hooks
one stone pitcher one stone cup three Peter Dishes two Peter Basons five
peter plates two glasses Bottles one Looking glass one glass cup one
small table one small glass bottle the same to her and to her
disposers forever

Item I give and bequeath to Joseph Bradshaw five shillings
the same to him and his heirs forever
Lastly I do hereby appoint Edward Griffen to be executor
and Sole Executor of this my last will and testament
working and disannulling all other will or wills by me
heretofore mentioned or declared as witness my
