In the name of God Amen the 8th day of March in the
year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one I Sarah
O Mann in the province and County of Southampton being weak in
Body but in perfect memory and Since thankes be to God for it
therefore calling to mind the mortallity of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men
to die I do make and ordain this my last Will and testament and first of all I recommend my
soul to the hand of God that gave it and for my Body I recommend it to the earth to be buried
in decent like manner at the hands of my executor and as keeping such worldly estate as
herewith it hath been pleased God to bless me with I give and dispose as followeth
in the manner and form

I give to Ephraim Bryant one Cow and calf and one Pwe and Lamb
to him and his heirs forever and likewise two Pewter Plates and
eight spoons one dish and Bason and pot and Cooke iron.

I gave my Brother Janas one Dulchaven and one feather bed and furniture
and one washing tub and pail and piggie and two Chests and three
Chairs and four Glass Bottles and one tickler and one slab Iron
one meal wifter and Bag and meal Barrel and three baskets
and two Logs and all my meat and fat to him and his heirs forever and
Knives and forks

I do appoint my Brother James Bryant Executor to this my last will and testament whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this day and year above written
