the Parish of Saint Lukes and County of Southampton at present
very Sick and weak of Body but of sound mind and
memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and
form following to wit:

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Nancy Harris all my Estates of
Kinds either Real or personal of all sorts whatsoever to her and her heirs forever
but should my Daughter Nancy Harris die before she arrives to the age of
Twenty one or have lawfull Issue of her Body my Desire is my Estate be
equally divided Betwix all the Children that are then living of my
Four Brothers to wit Benjamin & Abraham Mchahend Hardy and
to be to them and their heirs forever.

I nominate and appoint my trusty friends Laurence Smith and Henry
Smith my lawful and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament in
Witness I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 6th of February one
Thousand seven hundred and ninety one
