I Charles Barham of Southampton County and parish of St. Luke being in that state of Health but of a weak and disposing mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following First and principally I commend my Soul to Almighty God the Creator of it and all things and as for what worldly Goods it hath been pleased God to bless me with I dispose of in manner following to wit

- Item I give and bequeath to my son Robert Barham the plantation shewen the number being two hundred and fifty acres more or less which I have hitherto given to him by a deed of Gift bearing date the twenty fourth day of February 1772 also four Negroes namely Dick Peter Sam and Bind together with their increase and the date of the aforesaid Deed which is three namely Lewis Fanny and Pansam which I land and Negroes with their increase I give to my Son Robert Barham to him and his heirs forever
- Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Milly Barham one feather Bed and Furniture to her and her heirs forever
- Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Harris Twenty shillings Current Money to her and her heirs forever
- Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Lucy Debach and Negro Man Name Tony to her and her heirs forever
- Item I give the use of three Negroes named Jenny Pogg and Tom also the use of their increase to Drury Parker during his life and after his death I give the said Negroes with their increase to be equally divided amongst all the Children that he had by my Daughter Elizabeth with said Negroes I give to them and their heirs forever
- Item I give and bequeath to my Grand son Joel Newsom one Negro Name Jeffrey which he has now in his possession to him and his heirs forever
- Item I give and bequeath to my Grandson Barham Newsom one Negro Girl Name Abigail which he has now in his possession to him and his heirs forever
- Item I give all wearing clothes to my son Robert Barham to him and his heirs forever
- Item I give and bequeath to my son James Barham four hundred and seventy acres of land which I have heretofore given him in a Deed of Gift bearing date the twenty fourth day of February 1772 I also give my son James Barham the following Negroes namely Frank Parham Abram Harry Mingo York Cain Lee Judah Venus Amy
