 Wills heretofore made by me In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 affixed my Seal this twentieth day of February 1791

I codicil to the Will annexed

Whereas I have omitted disposing of sundry
 species of property in my Will I take this method of directing my executors & it
 is my Will and desire that they make Sale of all and every species of property
 both real and personal not mentioned in my Will except the land where Ann
 Milton now lives the money arising from the same to be applied to the discharge of my
 debts my wife having it in her power to keep the lands during the term she has
 the other estate left her and then for them to return with the rest of the
 estate lent her to my Daughter Elizabeth provided she will undertake to
 pay one hundred pounds to my Creditors

I bind to Ann Milton Alias Ann Bonner the use of that tract of land
 whereon she now lives during her natural life with privilege to cut down
 one half thereof only after her death I give and confirm a just right and
 title of the said or above mentioned Land to Fanny Milton so called
 daughter to Ann Milton junior to her and her heirs forever
