In the name of God amen I William Foster of Southampton County being in a weak and low state of health but of sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my last Will and testament in manner and form following to wit. First I recommend my Soul to almighty god the Creator of that and all things and as for what worldy goods it hath been please God to bless me with I dispose of in manner following
Item I bind to my loving wife Edith Foster my lands whereon I now live with all my Negroes Stock of all kinds house hold and kitchen furniture and all the remainder of my estate which said lands Negroes Stock and other estate I bind to my said wife during her life or till my Youngest Child Comes to the age of Fifteen Years
Item I give and bequeath to my two sons John and William Foster after the death of my wife my lands to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath all the remainder of my estate to be equally divided when my Youngest Child Comes to the age of fourteen or fifteen Years amongst my wife Edith and my four Children John Foster Wm Foster
