1783 I John Calthorpe of the County of Southampton being of sound
and disposing mind and memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following Vizo First and foremost I recommend my soul
to Almighty God who gave it in hope of joyfull resurrection of the same and as for
my worldly goods I dispose of as followeth. Imp^o. Item I give to my Son John
Calthorpe my Negroe Girls Celah and Lucy to him and his heirs forever
Item I give to my son James Calthorpe all my Land also one Negro Girl Felli and feather
bed and furniture that he commonly lies on to him and his heirs forever
Item I give to my son Henry Calthorpe my Negro Girl Amey and Negro boy
Frank also 1 feather bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever
Item I give to my son Howell Calthorpe Ten shillings
Item I leave my two Negroes Rochell and Will together with all the remainder
of my estate both Real and personal to be sold and the money equally
divided after my Just Debts being paid Between my three sons John James
and Henry Calthorpe to them and their heirs forever
and I do hereby appoint my son John and James Calthorpe whole and sole
executors of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I
have set my hand and affixed my Seal this day and Date first
above written
