1789

In the name of God amen I Henry Turner of
the County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke being sick and weak of body
but of sound mind and memory thanks be to god for the same do make and ordain this
my last Will and Testament in the following manner and form —
I give and bequeath to my son Jacob Turner all that Tract or parcel of Land now
Lieu on containing two hundred acres more or less beginning at the mouth of Branch
a dividing line between Capt. Nicholas Maggs and my self thence up the said
branch to the head thereof along a line of marked trees to Arthur Whitcheads line thence
a length the said Whitcheads line to the great Branch thence down the said branch to the
swamp and down the various courses of the swamp to the beginning to him and his
heirs forever —

I give and devise to Daughter Mary Parker five Shillings to she and her heirs forever
I give and devise to my Grand Daughter Patience Turner one Hollar to her
heirs forever —

I give all the residue of my estate both real and personal to be equally
divided between my Son Jacob Turner and all his children that is now
Living Henry Turner Elizabeth Turner Rebecca Turner Patience
Turner Milly Turner Sarah Turner William Turner to them and their heirs forever
I do hereby appoint my son Jacob Turner my whole and sole Executor to this my
last Will and Testament and do hereby revoke all other Wills by me
before made ratifying this and no other to be my last Will and Testament
in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this the 15th
day of December 1789
