I also give to my said Nephew Lewis Fort in trust for my beloved Niece Lucy Fort the said Lewis's Sister fifty pounds to be laid out for her use as my said Nephew and trustee may think proper and most for her benefit

Lastly I do nominate and appoint my said Nephew Lewis Fort Executor of this my last Will and testament revoking all former Wills by me heretofore made and making this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this twenty second day of January 1792 Signed Sealed and acknowledged
