In the name of God amen I John Brattle of the County of Southampton in Virginia being Sick & weak but of sound mind and perfect memory do make and give this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows to wit
 1st I Give unto my Son William Brattle five Shillings to be his full share of my whole Estate
 2^{ly} I give to my Daughter Famer Brattle one Feather Bed and Furniture or five pounds which she makes choice of
 3^{ly} I leave my land and plantation to be sold and the money to be equally divided between four youngest sons namely Benjamin Joseph Brattle Beasant Brattle & Adrian
