said with full liberty to carry the same during the time she may live unmarried

I give devise and bequeath to my son Jesse Draper the plantation  
whereon I now live containing by estimation one hundred and  
twenty five acres and bounded as follows to wit beginning at the  
mouth of the steepney neck branch and up said branch to the  
head thence along a line of marked trees to a branch call the  
middle point branch and up the said branch to a crooked  
pine thence a long line of marked trees to the poplar branch  
and down said branch to black Creek swamp down said swamp  
to the beginning together with an entry adjoining the said land  
to him his heirs and assigns forever also one long gun one  
long chest one square table also my sharing of a sor

relly I give devise and bequeath to my son Jeremiah Draper a tract  
of land containing by estimation twenty five acres and  
bounded as follows to wit beginning at a pine in Halls  
line thence along a line of marked trees to a large pine in  
harnases branch thence along a line of marked trees and east  
course to a white oak a corner tree thence a south east to  
Rickses path and thence along a line of marked trees to  
the beginning it being a part of land I bought of John Worrel  
to him his heirs and assigns forever I also give to my son  
Jeremiah Draper my riding saddle

fully I give devise and bequeath to my son Ephraim Draper all  
the remaining part of my land it being by Estimation one hundred  
and fifty acres to him and his heirs and assigns forever also  
all my blacksmith tools I give to Ephraim Draper one  
long gun

I give and bequeath to my son William Draper my riding  
saddle also one long gun

I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Draper ten  
shillings cash also one piece of Silver buckles

I give to my Daughter Sarah Jordan five shillings cash

I give devise and bequeath to my Daughter Mourning Draper  
all the remaining part of my estate of all kinds both in  
down and out down to her heirs and assigns forever  
and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son  
Jesse Draper whole & sole executor to this my last will
