Impr. — My Negro man Mingo having served me faithfully & honestly I hereby manumit and set him free I give him the shoemakers and coopers tools which he now works with

Item I give and bequeath to Mary Locke the wife of William Locke of Purry my Negro Girl Aggy to her & her heirs
I All the rest and residue of my Estate both real personal and mixed or whereever found I give devise and bequeath to my friend Samuel Wells and to his heirs forever. I do hereby appoint my S. friend Wells to be the executor of this my last will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 3rd day of September one thousand seven hundred & eighty nine Signed Sealed published & declared by the testator in presence of
