At a court^{int} held for the county of Southampton on Friday the 13th day of July 1792. This will was proved by the oath of Benjamin Dren one of the witnesses thereto and the codicil thereto annexed by the oath of Jn: D. Hauffmann a witness thereto who also deposed that he heard the said Moses Phillips acknowledge this writing as his last will & testament. And at a court held for the county of Southampton the 8th day of March 1792. This will was fully proved by the oath of Francis Young jun: another witness thereto and together with the codicil ordered to be read. And on the motion of Samuel Hells the executor therein named who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon &c.
