In the Name of God Amens. I Mary Murray of the
County of Southampton & state of Virg^a: being in perfect sound mind &
memory do ordain & make this my last will & Testament &c. &c.
I send unto my daughter Elizabeth Smith one hundred & thirteen
acres of land adjoining Benj^a Barham's land which said land I
formerly purchased of the s^r Barham also four Negroes, to wit Len-
tley Edy and Dina with their increase likewise one black per-
son ten cattle ten Sheep & one third part of the Hogs which shall be found
of mine at my decease under my new mark: also two walnut tables one Walnut
desk & looking Glass two beds & furniture two Chests two trunks one case
of bottles one copper Kettle two Iron pots one Dutch oven & sundry small
necessaries. The intent & meaning of this my last will & testament is
that I send the above land & slaves, as also the enumerated articles to
my daughter Eliz^a Smith during her natural life for her & her son
William Alexander Smith's support & maintenance agreeable to my
afore^d Daughters will & pleasure. At the decease of my daughter
Eliz^a Smith; send the afores^d land slaves & articles unto my grandson
W^m Alexander Smith & his heirs lawfully begotten of his body but
in case in the said W^m Alexander Smith should die without leaving
Issue then the afores^d land slaves & articles to return to the nearest in
blood to his Mother Eliz^a Smith.

Item

The residue of my stock of cattle &c. under my new mark & what
ever else of mine or wheresoever found after my decease to be equally
divided between Mary Harwood & Sarah Maget al the heirs of the blood.
And I further direct and desire that there be no Inventory or Appraisement
taken of my Estate. My last will and desire is, that John Karrow
William Maget & Elizabeth Smith do act & qualify as executors to this my
last Will and testament, hereby revoking, annulling & making void all other
Wills by me heretofore made. In witness whereof I the testator hath
hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this seventeenth day of January
& in the year a^r d^r lord christ, One thousand seven hundred and ninety one.
