This will was presented in court proved by the oaths of Geo^{rs} Fisher & Benj^m Barham two of the witnesses thereto & continued for the entry to qualify. And at a court held for the S^d county of Southampton the 13th day of Sept^r 1792. This will was further proved by the oath of W^m Holliman another witness thereto Benj^m Barham one of the former witnesses relinq^{uishing} all his right to the S^d will & desired to be recorded. And at a court held for the S^d county of Southampton the 11th day of Oct^r 1792 on the motion of Geo^{rs} Summers Esq^r who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of adm^{on} with the S^d will annexed (the test^r refusing to qualify) on the estate of the S^d decedent giving security whereupon &c.

In the Name of God Amen I Burwell Williamson of the County of Southampton being sick at present but of sound & disposing mind and Memory thanks be to God for the same do make and Constitute this writing as my last Will and Testament in manner & form following (to wit)

I leave the use profits and Occupation of all my lands to my beloved wife Lucy Williamson for and during the term of her natural life ---

I give to my daughter Wilmoth Jordan all the Negroes which I have heretofore possessed her off & to her heirs also I give to my said daughter Wilmoth Jordan & to her heirs the following Negroes (to wit) Janet and Robin also one hundred pounds Cash I also give to my S^d daughter Wilmoth Jordan & to her heirs forever the land and plantation which I possess on seacoast but not to have possession of the S^d land till after the death of my above S^d wife but in case my S^d daughter Wilmoth depart this life in the lifetime of my wife & leaving no living issue that then in such case my will and desire is that my loving wife Lucy Williamson shall have power to dispose of the above S^d lands & other property, wher by will or deed to any person or persons she may think proper ---

I give to my daughter Nancy Williamson and to her heirs forever the following Negroes (to wit) Dick Tom Lewis George Brittain Cloe their child Polly & child Judah & Any one sower Mare Bridle & saddle one chest of Drawers two feather beds & furniture & one hundred pounds current money I also give & desire to my S^d daug Nancy Williamson & to her heirs all the remainder part of my lands not heretofore mentioned to her & her heirs forever but not to possess the same till after the death of my S^d wife as above mentioned but in case my daughter Nancy Williamson depart this life in the lifetime of my wife and without
