

I desire that all my property I have lent unto my daughter Elizabeth may be sold by my Execr. and the money arising from the sale put out to Int. for the use and behoof of my Granddaughter Jane Easum Mecombe to whom on her arrival at the age of twenty one years I give the amount of the said sales principal & Int. but should my granddaughter die under or before the age of twenty one years I then desire that the money afores<sup>d</sup> accruing from the sale of my property lent my daughter Elizabeth should be equally divided amongst my sons to whom I in such case give it in the same manner as I give them my Negroes.

Lastly;

My will and desire is that my sons Easum & Michael at their joint expence shall build for their sister Rebecca Mecombe a good log house sixteen feet square with plank floors & a shingled roof on the land I have allotted for her to live in. I also desire that all and every part of my estate not herein devised, or lent or given away may after my death be set up and sold to the best bidders and the money arising from the sales after my just debts & funeral expences are paid, be equally divided amongst my six sons as aforesaid in same manner as I have given them my Negroes - to whom I give it & my negroes not herein particularly named in manner aforesaid to my sons forever.

Lastly:

I constitute and appoint my friends William Hines (sheriff) my son Michael Cobb and Thomas Gray, Execr. of this my last will & testament and desire that they will act as trustees for my daughter Rebecca Mecombe and hereby leave to them in trust my grey horse & Cart for her use and further desire that all I have lent her shall be held by them as her trustees for her use only in such manner that Samuel Mecombe shall not possess or receive or in any manner be Benefitted by any part of my estate and at the sale thereof I desire that he may not be suffered to buy any thing that has life. I furthermore desire that all my negroes not herein mentioned may be equally divided amongst my six sons as is before mentioned in same manner as is before
