Daughter Ridley may have her choice of one cow out of my stock of cattle then remaining I give and bequeath to my Daughter Lucy Stephens a negro girl married I am to her and her heirs forever - It is my will & desire that all the rest & residue of my estate be it of what nature kind or quality sower (except one house Mill which I hereby give and bequeath to my son Benjamin and which I desire may not be moved from the place she now stands upon) may remain in the possession of my living wife Mary for & during the term of her natural life or widowhood and after the decease of my s^d. wife the same be equally divided between all my Children then living to them and their heirs forever. And further I do hereby constitute and appoint my sons Jacob & Benjamin Bradshaw my whole and sole exors. of this my last will & Testament & Guardians to all my Children under age - In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 26th day of March in the year of our Lord 1790. -
