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shall cease the utterly void & take effect upon & devolve to my son Robert
 Freed under the like limitations & in case he shall act contrary to the promise
 in like manner then the same shall descend & pass to my son Edwin
 to either of my s^{ons} whichever it may remain upon to his heirs
 and assigns forever —

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Milly Freed in her own right
 of common age & age to be set apart at the division of the remainder
 of my estate to her and to her heirs forever —

Item I hereby leave as much of my estate as can be best spared to be sold
 at public outcry as will with my out standing debts be sufficient to pur-
 chase a Negro Girl of ten or twelve years of age —

Item I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Ann Freed the house & her
 holdalls to her & to her heirs and assigns forever —

Item I leave unto my loving wife Ann Freed all the remainder of my estate
 of what nature or kind soever during her natural life or widowhood to be
 held & kept together & necessarily applied to the support & maintenance
 of my children within ages at the time of my death in case of marriage
 should my executors or in any case should they discover shall the estate
 given her is waisting then in that case it shall & may be lawful & they are
 required to take immediately possession & make an equal division of the
 same amongst my wife & all my Children; first reserving money sufficient in their
 opinions to school my son Robert Freed to the learning of the rules of grammar
 and fellowship to them & their heirs respectively forever — But in case
 my s^{on} Robert shall require his learning before either event he is to
 have it then necessary —

Lastly I constitute and appoint my friends John Johnson & Josiah Dick
 my whole & sole executors of this my last will & Testament revoking & disannulling all
 Will or wills by me hitherto made and allowing this and no other to be my last
 Will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
 my seal this fourteenth day of September 1790 —
