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In the Name of God Amen I Matthew Jones of the parish of Malloway
 and County of Southampton being weak in body but of sound mind Memory and
 Judgment (Pleased to God) and well knowing the uncertainty of this life do this 26th
 of July in the year of our Lord 1793 make adain Publish and declare this Indiment
 writing to be my Last will and Testament -

First I give and Bequeath unto my son Alldighton Jones and his heirs & his body
 Lawfully begotten forever all my Lands Lying and being in the Parish of Blacks
 water & Malloway rivers situate in the County of Southampton which Lands was left me
 by my father Also I give and Bequeath to my said son All Jones the following Negro's
 (to wit) Roger Jean Phillis and Patt Jossy I Give the above Negro's to him my son Alldighton
 Jones and his Lawfull heirs forever - Also I Give and Bequeath unto my daughter
 Sarah Jones and her heirs forever the following Negro's (to wit) Doll James Sampson
 and Jacob - Also I Give unto my daughter Ann Jones and her heirs forever the
 following Negro's Namely Moses Sarah Fanny and Charles - Also I Give devise
 and Bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Jones and her heirs forever the following
 Negro's Namely Luc Cato Judith and Dolls youngest child (which is not yet named)
 Also I Give devise and Bequeath unto my Sister Mary Saville and her heirs
 forever one Negro Girl called Amey - Also it is my will & desire that all my stock
 of whatever kind sever to be sold as well as my household & Kitchen furniture &c. &c.
 Credit and the Money arising from the Sale be appropriated to the payment of my
 Just debts - And lastly I do nominate and appoint my Brother Alldighton
 Jones my whole & Sole Executor as well as Guardian to my son Alldighton Jones
 daughters Sarah Ann & Elizabeth In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and affixed my seal the day & year first above Written
