In the name of God Amen I John Rose of Southampton County being weak of body but of sound mind & memory do make and ordain this to be my last will & Testament as follows to wit I give and bequeath to my son John Rose five shillings current money to him & his heirs forever I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Rose one feather bed & furniture to his choice but if my son Joseph Rose should not return to receive it then s^t bed to be sold to the highest bidder and the money ~~being~~ To be divided Between my two youngest sons to wit Edwin Rose and Lewis Rose Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Rose five pounds current money of Virginia to her & her heirs forever Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Susan Rose five pounds current money to her and her heirs forever Item I give and bequeath to my two sons Edwin Rose and Lewis Rose all the remainder of my estate of what nature kind ever or where ever found after my debts & other Expenses & legacies already mentioned are satisfied My will and desire is that all the said remainder be published sold & the money equally divided between my two said youngest sons Item And lastly I constitute & appoint M. Benjⁿ Colwell jr my whole & sole executor of this my last will and Testament revoking all other wills by me made heretofore In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed seal this 15th day of May In the year of our Lord 1793 Signed Sealed & acknowledged to be the last will of the testator

In the name of God Amen I Nathan Barnes of the County of Pitt being in health at present (thanks be to God) but calling to mind the mortality of my body throwing that it is appointed for all to die do constitute & ordain this my last will & Testament in form & manner follows I give to my loving wife Martha five Negroes Rachel David Cherry Ester & Jacob to her & her heirs forever Also I give her all the house hold & kitchen furniture she was possid of for the day she married with her during life Also I lend her the use of one third of my land and one Negro man Jacob during her life in widowhood Item I give to my son John Barnes one half of my land & plantation I am now in possession of also two Negroes Puff & Coof to him & his heirs forever Item I give to my son Britain Barnes two Neg Cherry & George one feather bed & furniture & small felly to him & his heirs forever Item I give to my son Samuel Barnes the other half of my land and plantation also two Negroes David & Harriet to his heirs forever
