 and the balance to be equally divided between my loving wife Martha & my
 children John Britain Cordell & Leany and I do also appoint my wife Martha
 son John & David Barrow Executors of this my Last will & Testament annulling
 all former wills and confirming this to be my Last will & Testament Given
 under my hand ~~this~~ and Seal this 15 day of June Anno Domini 1790

It is Court held for the County of Southampton the 18 day of October 1793. The writing
 Purporting the last will & Testament of Nathan Barnes dec'd was presented in
 court whereupon James Wilkinson Benjⁿ Drew & William Wick junior being sworn
 deposed that they believe the said will was wholly written & signed by the said
 Nathan Barnes on consideration whereof the said writing is established as the
 last will & Testament of Nathan Barnes and ordered to be recorded and on the
 motion of John Barnes one of the Petors therein named who made oath according
 to Law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form giving
 Security whereupon &c.

Suppl^d Note In the name of God Amen I Robert Taylor of the county of Flon being weak
 in body tho of sound mind ^{and memory} and willing to prevent disputes about
 my estate after my death do make this my last will & Testament in manner
 and form following (to wit) I Impower Give & bequeath to niece Patsy
 Woodlief daughter of Tho^s & Martha Woodlief the six following Negroes to wit
 Judy her child Fanny Mary Lydia Jimmy & Doll to her & her heirs but
 should my said niece Patsy Woodlief die before she arrives to the age of Twenty one
 or marries then my desire is that the Estate left her should be equally
 divided between my five relations (to wit) Wm Browne & Ann Browne descendants
 of Wm Ann Browne deceased, Samuel Browne Martha Browne & Mary Browne
 children of Benjamin Edwards & Mary Mason Browne which Estate I Give to
 them and their heirs — Item I Give and bequeath to my nephew Wm Browne
 son of Wm & Ann Browne deceased the five following Negroes to wit Dinah & her
 children Lucy, Amos, Beck & Jack, to him and his heirs but should he die
 under the age of twenty one I desire that estate left him be equally divided
 between his Sister Anne Browne & the surviving children of Benjⁿ Edwards &c.
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
