ordain this my last will and Testament in manner & form following - First I give the  
use of my land & plantation wherow I now live unto my wife Cala Jr and during her  
natural life I also give her the use of my stock of horses cattle hogs & sheep Jr and  
during the term of her natural life also all my household Kitchen furniture  
my plantation utensials with my carts & wheels & ploughs Jr and during her  
natural life. Except one feather bed & furniture which said bed & furniture  
I give to my daughter Lucy Johnson & her heirs forever. Also land unto my said  
wife Cala the use & labour of the following negroes during her natural life Little  
Dick, Harry, Ben Wills, Isham Braston, Solomon, Little Dick, Blaiborne, Dill,  
& Lucy - Secondly I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Gillum  
my negroes Sam, Peg, Amey, Poll, & Hannah, to him and his heirs forever  
Thirdly I give unto my daughter Mary Tucker Twenty five pounds  
I leave my negroes Phillis & her child George to be sold and the money to be  
applied
