I Thomas Gilliam of Stm County being of sound disposing mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner & form following: first I give the use of my land & plantation whereon I now live unto my wife Calia for and during her natural life I also give her the use of my flock of Horses cattle Hogs & Sheep for and during the term of her natural life also all my household & kitchen furniture my plantation utensils with my carts & wheels & ploughs for and during her natural life. Except one feather bed & furniture which said bed & furniture I give to my daughter Lucy Johnson & her heirs forever. I also lend unto my said wife Calia the use & labour of the following negroes during her natural life to wit Dick, Henry, Ben. Will, Loham Braston, Solomon, Little Dick, Claiborne, Dole & Lucy. Secondly I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Gilliam my Negroes Sam. Peg, Amey, Poll & Hannah, to him and his heirs forever. Thirdly I give unto my daughter Mary Tucker Twenty five pounds cash. I leave my Negroes Phillis & her child George to be sold and the money to be
