 7th I Give to four young Negroes now under my care namely Ellice, George, Calo & Charlotte each 20^l.
 8th My will & desire is that all my the remainder of my Estate may be equally divided amongst Thomas, Robert, Richard, Joseph, Mary, Millicent & Ann Richd. children of my brother Robert (Richd.) and Elizabeth Bailey & Sarah Bailey daughters of my Sister Elizabeth Scott (decd.) I constitute and appoint my Nephew Robert Richd. my whole and sole Executor to this my last will and testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 28 day of July 1792.

Thomas Peblew We court held for the county of St. John the 12th day of Dec^r 1793 This will was Ann Peblew Presented in court by Robert Richd. the Executor therein named (being one of Thomas Taylor the People called Quakers) and proved by the solemn affirmation of Thomas Peblew another of the People called Quakers and Ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the 1st Person who made affirmation according to Law certificate is granted him for Main a Probate thereof in due form giving security whereupon &c

In the name of God Amen I James Gardner Son of Southampton County & State of Virg^a being sick and weak of body but of sound & disposing mind & memory thanks be to Almighty God for the same and calling to mind the uncertainty of this life and knowing that it is appointed One for all men to die do make and ordain this my last will & testament in manner following first & principally I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God & my body to the Ground from whence it was Taken, hoping at the last day, to receive that Blessed Sentence, come ye Blessed Children of my Father Inherit the Kingdom prepared for you, before the Beginning, And also what worldly estate it hath pleased God to bestow on me. I Give and bequeath in manner & form following

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son James Gardner Sr. Ninety seven acres of woodland being part of a Survey executed by myself and James Daughtry, decd. bounded by the land of Col^l Bory Baker Matthew Baker Gardner, The county line & his own Land that he bought of John Daughtry to him his heirs and assigns forever. Item I Give and bequeath unto three of my Grandchildren Sons of my son W^m Gardner decd. (to wit) Jesse David & John the land & Plantation that I bought of Thos. Sharp containing Three hundred acres adjoining the Land now live on Nicholas Cobb & the tract that I Give my son Jesse Gardner bounding by a dividing line made between him & his tract by myself & Nicholas Cobb. to them their heirs and assigns forever equally. Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Jesse Gardner the Land and Plantation he now lives on bounded by a dividing line between this tract and the tract given to my Grand Children, Rob Darden and the county line thence by that line to the Back Swamp thence up the 5th Swamp to the aforesaid dividing line to the Beginning containing three hundred acres the residue to him also one hundred & twenty five acres bought Land purchased of Thos. Sharp agreed to be patented Granted Rob Bryant call'd & known by the name of Gall berry to him his heirs & assigns forever.
