In the name of God amen I John Claiborne of Southampton County calling to mind the uncertainty of human life do make and appoint this to be my last will & testament And first I recommend my soul to almighty God who gave it & my body to be buried in a Christian like manner at the direction of my Executors hereafter mentioned & as to what worldly goods it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I dispose of them in the manner following. — Item It is my desire that at my death the plantation whereon I now live containing four hundred acres more or less be divided by a line as follows Viz Beginning at a white Oak a corner tree on Bailey Fotters line fourth side of Durms Branch from thence an east course to Warden Kersers house thence N. East to the Needy branch to Barrows line all my lands on the North side of 5th line I lend to my loving wife Sally during her natural life & widowhood likewise all my stock of horses, cattle, Hogs, Sheep, House hold & Kitchen furniture plantation utensils &c. likewise a Neg. Wench Sarah for the term of ten years at expiration of which time It is my desire she be set free & likewise land her.
