Husband the use of my plantation with the advantage of my Orchard & house
fences and any and every advantage & profit belonging to said land & plantation
where I now live during her natural life or widowhood —

After or at the death of my wife Jane Ridley or Marriage I give bequeath
~~unto~~ to my friend and Brother by Law William Wright for the good will and
respect I bear for him the plantation I now lend to my wife Jane Ridley which
is where I now live to him & his heirs forever

Item

I Give to my beloved wife Jane Ridley all my negroes I now possess & their increase
to her and her disposal also all and every part of my estate real & personal
that I have not before mention'd or may hereafter fall to me by Law or otherwise
I also nominate my wife Jane Ridley and William Wright my whole
and sole Executors to this my last will & testament Given from under my hand
and seal this 26 day of Dec^r In the year of our Lord 1793
