Item— I lend the west room of the house that I now live in to my two daughters Ginny & Mary Pope as long as they live unmarried also lend them as much ground as is sufficient to make them cotton upon, I also give to my two daughters Ginny & Mary Pope each of them a feather bed and furniture and bird calls to each to them forever

Item— I give and bequeath to my son David Pope the remainder of my land undisposed of also my cott feather bed & furniture to him and his heirs forever

Item— I give and bequeath to my daughter Hannah Beal one cow & calf

Item— My will and desire is that the remainder of my estate undisposed of be equally divided between John Zeckiah Pope Hannah Soyner and Mary Popes, And I do hereby appoint my son Nathaniel Pope & Asa Beal Executors of this my last will and Testament In Witnes^s whereof I Jesse Pope have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this Twenty second day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one
