In the name of God amen I John Rockhill of the Parish of St. Luke's in the County of Hampshire being sick & weak of body but of sound mind & memory thanks be given to Almighty God for the same do make & constitute this my last will & Testament in form & manner following

In witness

I bequeath to my living wife Judith the use of all my lands and Plantations in Southampton county as also all my personal Estate, Bonds, Notes, & accounts during her life or in widowhood to use the same & profits thereof after payments of my debts as far as I think proper But should she marry I give Liberty to my house of such lands & of the lands & Tenements as is sufficient for the use of the Plantations

I also bequeath my wife Judith the use of all my slaves for the term of Twenty years or till Marriage for the support of herself & the Education & Support of my children but if she marry or die within the term of twenty years from the date hereof in either case I give her the sum of the following Pounds only vizt Ten, Five, Ten, great Ten, Dooz, & Dooz

My desire further is that should my said wife marry as aforesaid the term of Twenty years shall be void & I give all my Negroes not herein particularly named shall be divided & sold for the same
