As to the remainder of my lands & tenements I will in the County of Elizabeth, Prince George & at all times I desire in William & Mary's my will that they be rented out yearly and the profits arising therefrom be divided equally between my wife & my children as may be then living. And my will further is that in renting out my lands in Suffolk county Virginia & Westchester county South Carolina no more shall be made use of more than for the necessary support of the family. And I desire that no more lands be sold or on either

Lastly at the decease of my wife Judith my will is that the whole of my estate that I then shall be equally divided between such of my children as may be then living or the heirs of such as be dead if any draw a parents part

I do hereby appoint my brother Louis Rochelle Executor of this my last will & Testament allowing him 5% for trouble in settling my estate, or should he die before my estate is settled I appoint my friend James Butts to succeed him as my Executor to whom I allow the same 5% for what part shall turn in unsettled.
