

length of my children that may be then living. As to the remainder of my lands & movables while in the hands of Leachey since soon after my death he has been the sole owner of them, my will is that they be sold yearly and the profits arising therefrom be distributed equally between myself & each of my children as may be then living. But my wife further is that in venting out my lands such losses are to be incurred with carelessness & idleness shall be made more than for the necessary expences of the general distribution there are no more lands clearances on either.

Lastly at the decease of my wife I wish my will is that the whole of my estate that is then left be equally divided between such of my children as may be then living or the heirs of such as have died & any drawn parents part.

I Recollect appoint my brother Loui Rochelle Executor of this my last will & Testament allowing him 5<sup>£</sup> per mille in settling my estate, & should he die before my estate is settled I appoint my friend James Butt to succeed him as my Executor to whom I do leave the same 5<sup>£</sup> per mille per cent shall remain unsettled. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this thirtieth day of February 1794.
