At a court held for the county of St^{on} the 11 day of Sept^r 1794. This account current of the
Estate of Benjamin Clements deed was this day reported & Ordered to be recorded

In the name of God Amen I William Vaughan of St^{on} county being of sound & disposing
mind & memory thanks be to God for the same do make this my last will & testament in manner
following (to wit) I lend to my wife Ann Vaughan the use of my plantation wherein I
now live during her life or widowhood I lend to my wife three Negroes David Hannah &
Nancy during her life or widowhood also one bed & furniture also one horse to the value
of fifteen pounds together with my riding chain during her life or widowhood I give
my son William Vaughan after the death or marriage of my wife Ann the plantation
& tract of land wherein I now live containing one hundred & twenty five acres be the
same more or less to him & his heirs forever I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas
Vaughan the tract of land known by the name of brooks containing one hundred & thirty
more or less to him & his heirs forever I give & bequeath unto my son James Vaughan the tract
of land I purchased of Sam Nicholson containing two hundred & fifty acres more or less to him
& his heirs forever I give & bequeath unto my son William Vaughan after the death or marriage
of my wife Ann the whole of my dwelling house furniture except my bed & furniture given
I give unto my sons William Vaughan John Vaughan Thomas Vaughan James Vaughan
Vaughan & Howell Vaughan one each & the furniture thereunto belonging but should I
not be & furniture sufficient for my wife & each of my above mentioned children to
have one a piece that my Ex^{ors} shall buy out of the money arising from the sale of the
whole my stock of all kinds crop & plantation utensils a bed & furniture for each child
that lacks one and the bal^l of money arising from the sale & debts due me after
paying my just debts & funeral expenses be equally divided between their surviving
children to be put at ~~their~~ Interest & to receive their proportions of the said money
when each child arrives to the age twenty one years old as to my negroes my will and
desire is that they be equally divided between my children by such persons as the court
