In the name of God Amen I Moses Booth of the Parish of Malloway
Southampton do make Ordain this to my last will & testament
First it is my desire that my just debts & funeral expenses should be paid
by the sale of the brandy which may be made on my plantation this present year
Secondly I give to my loving wife Diana Booth the use of the plantation on which
I now live & also a part of all the personal property of which I die, to be to her
her also the use of the following Negroes viz Peter Isaac Hannah Molly Ephraim
Gilbert during her widowhood Thirdly I bequeath to my son Peter Booth the
Purchase of Benjamin Phillips on the North side of the Lightwood Swamp con-
taining by estimation Two Hundred acres also a tract of land on the afore said
Swamp which I purchased of Phillips Booth Also one small tract of land as part
which I purchased of Henry Blum containing forty five & a half Acres to him
Fourthly I bequeath to my aforementioned son Peter the following Negroes old Harry
Joan Harry, Daniel, Beck, Amy Lucy, Betty & Dill & also one third part of my
personal estate to him & his heirs Fifthly I bequeath to my son John Booth
Hundred & Twenty Two acres of land which I purchased of Moses Booth also the
plantation on which I now live after the marriage or decease of my wife
Sixthly I bequeath to my said son John Booth the following Negroes Roger Ben, Leah, Alice
Sydney, Isiah & Daniel & Young Henry Also one third part of my personal
estate to him & his heirs Seventhly I bequeath to my daughter Martha Warren
the following Negroes Pleasant & her children Tombo Judith Dick & Mary
with the future increase of the said Negro woman Pleasant to my daughter
