girl Solah & her increase also at the death of Mr. Clifton my Negro fellow slave during
his life and at his death I give them to his heirs forever

Him I give to my son Sarah Westbrook one feather bed & furniture the
possession and these Sheets and my Gun to him and his heirs forever

Him I bind to my son Zachariah Westbrook the use of my Negro boy Jack likewise my Neg
girl Poll and her increase during his life and at his decease to his heirs forever

Him I give to my son Zachariah Westbrook the sum of Ten pounds cash to be paid out of my
Estate One feather bed & furniture to him and his heirs forever

Him I bind to my daughter Betsy Dolly Westbrook the use of my Negress woman Diah & her
increase likewise likewise my Negro girl Millie & her increase during the term of her life
and at her decease to her lawfully begotten of her body forever Item I give to my
daughter Betsy Dolly Westbrook one feather bed and furniture (call'd my Bed)
likewise one small house call'd Jack and also one trunk to her & her heirs forever
And if either of the said parties die without heirs lawfully begotten of their bodies
my desire is the Negroes of the deceased be not sold, but equally divided between the
surviving ones as the case might be

Him My will and desire is that all the remainder part of my Estate be paid / best in
what kind soon / all my just debts paid and the remainder together with all just
debts due me be equally divided between Sarah Westbrook Zachariah Westbrook
and Betsy Dolly Westbrook

I do appoint Howell Scarbrough Robert Murrell Preacher Executors of this my last
will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 22nd
day of December 1794

At a court held for the county of Southampton the 8th day of January 1795 This will was presented
in court by Howell Scarbrough & Robert Murrell Preachers the Executors therein named, proved
by the oaths of William Marks & Ann Westbrook two of the witnesses thereto And ordered to be
recorded And the said Executors refusing to take upon themselves the burthen of the ex-
ecution thereof On the motion of Edwin Cland who made oath according to law certificate
is granted him for obtaining letters of administration with this will annex'd on the estate
of the said decedent giving security whereupon it is
