

Hon I send to my son Saml Westbrooke the use of my Negro boy Buck & likewise my Neg
 girl Sarah & her increase, also at the death of Miss Clifton my Negro fellow like, during
 his life and at his death, give them to his heirs forever
 Hon I give to my son Saml Westbrooke one Parcel Horse one feather bed & furniture one
 gun and three Shirts and my Gun to him and his heirs forever
 Hon I send to my son Zachariah Westbrooke the use of my Negro boy Jack & likewise my Neg
 girl Poll and her increase during his life and at his decease to his heirs forever
 Hon I give to my son Zachariah Westbrooke the sum of Ten pounds back to be paid out of my
 Estate one feather bed & furniture to him and his heirs forever
 Hon I send to my daughter Betty Dolly Westbrooke the use of my Negro woman Dinah & her
 Increase hereafter Likewise my Negro girl Milly & her increase during the term of her life
 and at her decease to her lawfully begotten of her body forever Hon I give to my
 daughter Betty Dolly Westbrooke one feather bed and furniture (call it my bed)
 likewise one small Horse called Jack and also one trunk to her & her heirs forever
 And if either of the said parties die without heirs lawfully begotten of their body
 my desire is the Negro of the decease be not sold, but equally divided between the
 surviving ones as the case might be
 Hon My will and desire is that all the remainder part of my Estate be paid / but in
 what kind soon / all my just debts paid and the remainder to gather with all just
 debts due one be equally divided between Saml Westbrooke Zachariah Westbrooke
 and Betty Dolly Westbrooke
 I do appoint Howell Lashbough & Robert Murrell / Executors of this my last
 will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 22^d
 day of December 1794

 ecution thereof On the motion of Rawin Cland who made oath according to law certificate
 is granted him for obtaining letters of administration with this will annexed on the estate
 of the said decedent giving security whereupon &c.
