

In the name of God Amen November 6th in the year of our Lord 1794 I John
 Turner of the county of Southampton being at this time weak in body though firm
 in mind & knowing that it is appointed for man once to die do constitute
 & make this my last will and testament revoking all others by me ^{heretofore} made in man-
 ner & form as follows Viz

Impimus I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife during her natural life or widowhood the
 plantation whereon I now live with all the plantation utensils also the following
 slaves to wit, Simon, Aaron, Hannah, Olive & yellow Patsience also three horses ^{as my wife may make choice of} also two beds & furniture three cows & calves & the flock
 of hogs together with 15 sheep & one saddle & bridle After the death or marriage
 of my wife it is my will & desire that my plantation should go to my son Walter &
 in case of his death without issue to go to my beloved son Matthew Turner & the per-
 sonal Estate left my said wife it my will & desire should be sold after the death
 of my wife and divided between my son Walter & daughters Sally & Eliza &
 their heirs

Impimus I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Matthew Turner this during his life
 the following slaves to wit Daniel, Sam. Robin & Arny one feather bed & furniture
 one Buckskin cot One cow & calf & one pig & two Lambs

Impimus I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Walter Turner the following slaves Viz
 Robin & Patsience also one bed & furniture one cow & calf & at the death or marriage
 of my said wife the plantation I now live on

Impimus I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Sally Turner to her & her heirs forever
 the following slaves Viz Sealy & Mourning, Mourning to be sold & the money
 arising from her sale to be laid out in a negro boy also one bed & furniture
 & one cow & calf

Impimus I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Eliza Turner the following slaves
 Viz Darcas & little Sealy also one feather bed & furniture & one cow & calf & her
 & her heirs forever

Lastly I give unto my beloved wife my crop of corn & fodder which is made on my said
 plantation this year

I Nominate & appoint my friends William Boykin Joel Boykin & John Hughes
 Executors to this my last will & Testament Signed the day & year & day above
 mentioned before the witnesses Viz
