 make & ordain this & no other to be my last will & Testament hereby Revoking & making void all
 former wills heretofore made by

I Give and bequeath my soul to God that gave it Truly trusting through the Mediations of my
 Saviour Jesus Christ to receive the same at the General Resurrection & my body to
 be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors herein after named & of my real &
 personal Estate I Give and dispose of it in manner & form following

I Give and bequeath unto my son John Johnson part of the land I now live on beginning
 at a branch that runs across my land at John T Blows line formerly Savills thence along
 the said Blows line to Benjamin Williams line thence along the said Bing Williams
 line to Thomas Williams's line thence along the said Tho. Williams's line to the said
 branch thence up the said branch to the Beginning to him & his heirs forever wit^h part
 of the land whereon I live

I Give and bequeath to my loving wife Ann Johnson 1/3 part of the remainder of the land
 whereon I now live which is not ^{part} disposed of with a lease the House is thereon & her choice of houses
 then on the plantation with 1/3 part of the remainder of my moveable Estate during her
 life or widowhood & after her decease or day of Marriage all the land to her given with all
 the rest of my land to fall & descend to my son John Johnson & his heirs forever

My will & desire is that all the remainder of my moveable Estate may be equally divided be-
 tween my 6 Children Now living & after the death of my Wife Ann Johnson & if she
 should Marry then all the Estate to her given the land Excepted to be equally divided
 between my five Children aforesaid

Lastly I make & Ordain my son John Johnson & my son ^{in law} William Pope my sole &
 sole Executors of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand & affixed my seal this 30th day of January 1779
