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on the east side Toquaghtkunta swamp near Williams's crossing thence along a line of marked trees Easterly to the cleared ground whereon I now live thence by the said cleared ground a direct line to a Gum near Cook's thence by crossing my plantation called Sarah Carter to a small pine near the head of a small branch thence down the run of the said branch to the great branch thence down the run of the said branch to Toquaghtkunta swamp aforesaid thence down the run of the said swamp to the Beginning

Item I Give & bequeath to my Son John this heirs forever all the residue of my lands known by the names of Betty Edwards & Herrings adjoining my other lands already given away

Item I Give & bequeath to my daughter Lucy & her heirs forever one Negro Girl named Fanny also the sum of fifty Pounds to be applied towards her Education

Item I Give and bequeath to my Grand daughter Charlotte Pittow & her heirs forever one Negro boy named Cato also the sum of twenty five Pounds to be delivered her at the age of Twenty one years or Marriage but if she dies before she arrives at the age of 21 years or marries me will is that the said Negro boy Cato & twenty five Pounds remain in my Estate

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son George Gurley the sum of three hundred Pounds at the day of my death & to carry Interest from that time till he arrives at the age of 21 years As to the remainder of my Estate my will & desire is that when my son William arrives to the age of Twenty one years after Payment of my debts & setting a part the house hereby given that the remainder be equally divided between all my children that shall then be living by my Executors hereafter named & that each receive their respective parts for their Support & Maintenance

Lastly I do appoint my son Henry George Gurley & his Executors of this my last will & Testament ratifying & confirming this & none other to be my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 29th day of December 1774
