In the Name of God Amen I Elizabeth Blunt of the county of Southampton being in my perfect sense & memory do make & ordain this my last will and Testament in manner & form as followeth to wit

I Give and bequeath unto my daughter Francis Briggs Lucas & her heirs forever all that tract or parcel of Land that I purchased of Lewis Grigg in the county of Greenville containing by Estimation thirty Acres but in case she should die without Issue or before Marriage then and in that case I Give & bequeath the said tract or parcel of Land unto my son Benj^m Blunt & to his heirs forever

I Give unto my daughter Francis Briggs Lucas one negro girl named Clarissa to her & her heirs forever But in case my said daughter Francis Briggs Lucas should die without Issue or before Marriage then & in that case I Give the said negro Clarissa unto my friends William Lucas (of Meclenburg) & Rebecca Rains (wife to Hartwell Rains) to be equally divided between them to them & their heirs forever

I do appoint my loving husband Samuel Blunt Executor of this my last will and Testament revoking all other wills by me heretofore made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 26th day of September 1794.
