At a court held for the county of Southampton the 12th day of March 1795 This will was presented in court by Joseph Prince one of the Executors therein named, sworn by the oaths of Jordan Pate & Richard Mason two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded And on the motion of the said Executor who made oath according to law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a Probate thereof in due form giving twenty whereupon the time being allowed for the Executors to qualify
