Turner one negro boy named Lewis during her life & after her death I give the said negro
boy to my Grand son Benjⁿ Turner to him & his heirs forever.
I give and bequeath unto my grandson Benjⁿ Bittle one negro boy named Moses to him
and his heirs forever.
I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Elizabeth Bittle daughter of Mildred
Turner one negro girl named Olive together with her future increase to her & her heirs forever.
I give and bequeath unto my son William Bittle the plantation tract of land
whereon now live containing 350 acres more or less to him & his heirs forever. I also
give and bequeath unto my son William Bittle one negrowoman named David
one negrowoman named Kitt one negro boy named Sam one negrowoman named
Sarah together with her future increase one negrowoman named Sue one neg
woman named Jenny one negro girl named Charlotte one negro girl named
Mason together with their future increase to him and his heirs forever. I like
wise give unto my son William Bittle after my just debts & funeral Expenses
are paid all the remaining part of my Estate of what nature or kind soever
to him and his heirs forever. I do constitute my sons Henry & William Bittle
sole & sole Executors to this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have here
