Secondly It is also my will and desire that after the death of my wife that all my estate of what kind soever land excepted be equally divided between all my children then living and my grandson Charles Stewart

Lastly I constitute and appoint my wife Lydia Stewart & my friend Robert Goodwyn Executors to this my last will and testament at the same time revoking & making null and void all former will & wills by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 5th day of March 1794
