 that my bed covers may be put into lots & equally divided between all my children Likewise
 I do give of my clothes in the same manner I give I give all the unmarried part of my estate
 to be sold & equally divided between all my children Likewise one equal part may be
 drawn & equally divided between Peter & Nancy Barham I give I give to Peter & Nancy
 Barham Negro boy Lewis to them & their heirs forever & if they should die before they come
 to the age of Twenty one years then for him to be sold & equally divided between all my
 children I give I do constitute & appoint my son Charles B. Nicholson & Bridget
 Lewis of this my last will & Testament I do Will & declare of Law & equity to let my
 hand & affix it my seal this 23rd day of September one thousand seven hundred & ninety five
