they must be supported out of the other part of my estate

I have the use of all my other estate both real & personal and should not
be bound to my wife for the support of her & all my children until my
youngest child Jack Cobb arrives or would arrive to the age of twenty years
there my wife & desire is that the whole be sold both real & personal & the money
arising to be equally divided between my wife & all my children to them and
their heirs forever and in case my wife should die or marry before my youngest
child as above mentioned arrives or would have arrived to the age of twenty years
my wife and desire is that the whole of my estate of what nature or kind so ever
shall then be sold and divided as above mentioned and in case the same
will not be sufficient for the payment of my just debts & not sufficient my wife & desire is that
my Executors shall sell such other part of my estate as they shall judge best for
that purpose the same received
