and parish of Nottoway being sick & weak in body & being
fully calling to mind the uncertainty of this mortal body do make constitute and
give & assign this and no other to be my last will & testament. First I give bequeath
and assign that all my lawfull debts & general charges be paid out of my estate Item
I give and bequeath to my five grand children Amy Gimmie Robert Gimmie
Ann Gimmie, Betsey Gimmie & Henry Gimmie the sum of twenty five
pounds lawfull money of Virginia to be equally divided amongst my said five
grand children, Item I also give to daughter Millicent Gimmie the just sum
of five shillings of lawfull money of Virginia and no more. Item I also give and
bequeath to my son in law Seymour Vaughan my negro boy Tom my boy Isaac
also my negro girl Nell and also my land whereon I now live containing two
hundred acres to the same more or less and all my movable estate with
provisional I give and bequeath to my son in law Seymour Vaughan during
his Natural life & except two Negroes Ned & Kate I give & bequeath to my grand
daughter Charlotte Cobb. Item I also give & bequeath to my grand daughter Susan
Vaughan my negro girl Cates first Child & the same I give & bequeath
the death of my son in law Seymour Vaughan. I give my three
Negroes Tom, Jacob & Nell as follows to my grand son Henry Vaughan I give
& bequeath my negro boy Jacob to him & his heirs forever I also give to my grand
son Shadrach Vaughan my negro boy Sam to him & his heirs forever I also give
& bequeath to my grand daughter Ann Vaughan my negro girl Nell
to her and her heirs forever I also in case of the death of my son in law
Seymour Vaughan or the death of my daughter Amy Vaughan do give
that if either of them dies & the other should marry again that they do
