 daughter Chirry Lowe one feather bed & Furniture One cow Half — Eighthly I Give to my
 daughter Nancy Lowe one feather bed & Furniture One cow Half
 And it my will and desire that if either of my two eldest sons should die
 without lawfull begotten heir that that lands shall fall to my son
 Simeon Lowe also if either of my three sons should die without issue
 I desire that that negro should be equally divided Between Simeon
