My will and devise is that all the remainder of my Estate of what kind or nature so
ever or wheresoever found be sold to pay my just debts & the remainder if any to my
brother Edwin Fort to him & to his heirs forever

And Lastly I constitute & appoint my friends Wm Chambley & Joseph Thorpe my
whole & sole Executors to this my last will & Testament hereby asking all others by me hereto-
fore made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 11 day of Feb 1795
