In the name of God Amen I John Andrews of Southhampton County being of sound mind and understanding bequeath to mine the certainty of death I make and ordain this my last will & testament in manner & form as follows. First I recommend my soul to Almighty God who is merciful & merciful to her & her heirs forever.

I give my daughter Sally Andrews these Negroes Scham Phillis & Sue also one feather bed & furniture to her & her heirs forever.

I give the use of my plantation and land and my Negro Tom & Ned to my wife Lucy Andrews during her life And at her death I give that my heirs full my plantation and land and the two Negs Tom & Ned & the money arising from the sale of my land Sally Andrews And the money arising from the sale of my Negro Tom to be equally divided between my two daughters Eliza Andrews and between my son James Andrews & my daughter Nancy Boykin.

My wife & I desire is that my heirs sell my Negro man Coffey & as much of my personal estate as will pay all my just debts.

All the remainder of my Estate not before given away both personal Estate & Negro I give the use of to my wife Lucy Andrews during her widowhood & at her marriage or death my wife is that the same be equally divided between my two daughters Eliza Andrews and Sally Andrews And I do appoint my friend Willm. Hagahast John Hagahast & my wife Lucy Andrews my Executors of this my last will & testament revoking all other wills by me made by me heretofore. Given under my hand this ninth day of June 1795.

At a court for the county of Southhampton the 11 day of February 1796. This writing bearing the last will & testament of John Andrews deceased was presented in court by Lucy Andrews the Exor therein named established by the depositions of Willm. Hagahast Jacob Turner & Daniel Butts & ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Exor the Exors therein named refusing to take upon themselves the burden of the execution thereof who made oath according to law certificate is granted for obtaining a probat thereof due from giving security. witness my hand & seal of office.

In the name of God Amen I Jacob Barnes of Southhampton County & State of Virginia being sick and weak in body but of sound memory & knowing it is appointed for a man to die do make & ordain this my last will & testament. Principally I first of all I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body to the ground to be buried in a Christian like manner. And as touching such worldly estate which it has pleased to bless me with in this life, I give in the following manner & form.

I give & bequeath to my own Benjamin Barnes one tract or parcel of land lying on the south side of the Cyprus Swamp. Beginning at a Maple in the North fork of the deep branch thence along a line of marked trees to the second branch & thence along the said second branch to James Barnes line thence along the said James Barnes line to three black gums & thence along the Meanders of the Cyprus Swamp to the Mouth of the deep branch and up the said branch to the last Station to him & his heirs and assigns forever.

I give & bequeath to my son Jacob Barnes one tract or parcel of land Beginning at
