Item I give and bequeath to my sons Joshua Barnes & William Barnes to be equally di-
vided between them one tract or parcel of land lying in Pitt county North Carolina
near Little Contently Creek to hold to my said sons & to their heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son James Barnes one tract or parcel of land lying
on the Currier's branch in Edgecomb County North Carolina to hold to my
said son & to his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I lend to my loving wife Elizabeth Barnes all the remainder of my estate of
all kinds for and during her life a widow & in case my wife Mary it is my
will & desire that the whole of my personal estate should be equally divided be-
tween my said wife and all my children. Or in case of the death of my wife be-
tween all my children provided that if any of my children should have had
any part of my personal estate before that time that the same be deducted
out of their part.

Item I do appoint my loving wife Elizabeth Barnes & son Josiah Barnes to execute this my
last will & testament revoking all other wills by me heretofore made In Witness
