the residue of my Estate of whatsoever it may consist of may be equally
divided between my three sons William Myrick, John Myrick
& Howel Myrick & that the Estate left me by my deceased husband
may be divided equal as his will directs. I also appoint my loving son
Myrick & my grandson Howel Jones whole & sole executors to this my last will & testament in witness
whereof I have set my hand & seal this 18th day of February 1795
